Part 3. Operational Rules and Procedures

- Fuel tax discount is only allowed on fuel purchased for a Tribal member's personal use.
- Resident Tribal member must be at least 16 years old.
- Resident Tribal members must register their vehicle and license plate number with the Business Regulations Department before obtaining the fuel tax discount.
- Tax-exempt fuel may only be dispensed into a registered vehicle or approved container.
- A Tribal member who is unable to drive due to a disability may obtain authorization from the Business Regulations Department to purchase fuel tax-exempt for the vehicle of a non-member spouse, family member or caretaker to provide transportation for the Tribal member.
- Fuel tax discount is only available at the Mount Pleasant Sagamok Gas Station.
- Tribal members must pre-identify themselves to the cashier and have their picture SCIT RTM Tribal ID with them.
NO PICTURE ID, NO DISCOUNT!
- Tribal member must complete log at the Mount Pleasant Sagamok Shell Station. Log the Date, Tribal ID#, Name, Signature, License Plate #, and check gasoline or diesel box.
- A Resident Tribal Member (RTM) must turn their RTM ID if they move out of the Tax Agreement Area to the Business Regulations Department.
- Tribal member must keep track of their own tax-exempt gallons. Monthly limits will be enforced.
- Penalties will apply for failure to follow tax-exempt motor fuel rules.
- Fuel tax exemption program may be suspended by the Tribe at any time.
- The Tribe may bar individual Tribal members from the fuel tax exemption program if operational rules and procedures are not followed.

Part 4. Certification

I declare, under penalty of perjury, that the information on this registration is true. **I understand that it is my responsibility to keep track of my tax-exempt fuel purchases and not exceed the monthly gallon limit of tax-exempt fuel.** I also understand that the monthly gallon limit may change and it is my responsibility to verify the current limit before I purchase tax-exempt fuel. In the event that I violate the fuel tax exemption rules and/or exceed the purchase limits, I accept full responsibility for the payment of tax, penalty and other remedies.

TAX-EXEMPT MOTOR FUEL PROGRAM

Fuel tax discount is only allowed on fuel purchased for a Tribal Member's personal use. Tribal Member must be 16 years old.

Tribal Members must register their vehicle and license plate number with the Business Regulations Department before obtaining the fuel tax discount. Tax-exempt fuel may only be dispensed into a registered vehicle or approved container.

A Tribal Member who is unable to drive due to a disability may obtain authorization, from the Business Regulations Department, to purchase fuel tax-exempt for the vehicle of a non-member spouse, family member, or caretaker to provide transportation for the Tribal Member.

Fuel tax discount is only available at the Mount Pleasant Sagamok Shell Gas Station. They are required to check your Tribal Resident Member ID at each purchase and complete additional paperwork in order for you to get your discount. **Please direct any concerns or complaints to the Business Regulations Department.**

Tribal Members must pre-identify themselves to the cashier and have their picture Tribal Resident Member ID with them.

NO TRIBAL RESIDENT MEMBER ID, NO DISCOUNT!!!

Tribal Member must complete log at the Sagamok Shell. Log the Date, Tribal ID #, Name, Signature, License Plate #, and check gasoline or diesel box.

A Resident Tribal Member (RTM) that moves out of the Agreement Area must turn the Tribal Resident Tribal Member ID to the Tribal Clerks Office when submitting a change of address form. Failure to do so will result in assessment of tax and penalties.

Tribal Members must keep track of their own tax-exempt gallons. Save your receipts to verify gallons purchased. Monthly limits will be enforced.

Penalties will apply for over-limit purchases, failure to register, dispensing fuel in an unregistered vehicle or claiming improper exemptions.

Fuel exemptions program may be suspended by the Tribe at any time.

The Tribe may bar individual Tribal Members from the fuel tax exemption program if operational rules and procedures are not followed.
