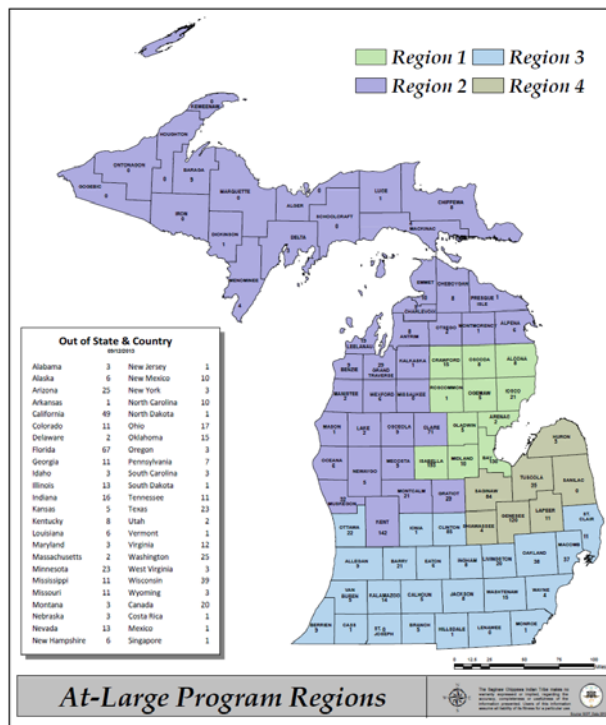

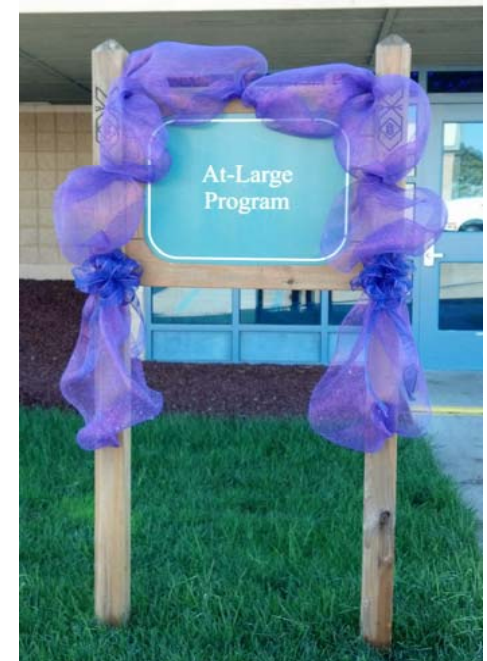
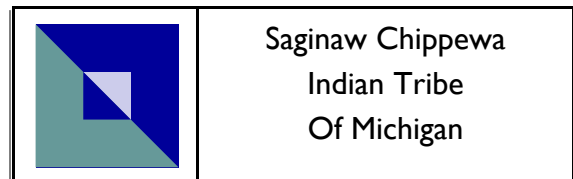

ADVOCACY

OUTREACH SERVICES

Outreach Services are offered on site, home visits, mail, email or by phone.

ELDERS SERVICES

Provide activities for personal growth and understanding our history through cultural and social events.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The various Elder events offer time to gather and maintain historical family ties which build a stronger sense of belonging, strong social ties and cultural identity.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Provide the opportunity for the Community to get acquainted with one another and the At-Large/Member Services Benefits Advisory Board, Council Representative and Staff Members.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- Promote traditional ways and teachings by offering Native activities.
