Project Overview: Install 1,174 linear feet of 5 foot high chain link fence.

Company Background: The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of MI is a federally recognized tribal government. The Saginaw Chippewa Housing Department (SCHD) is wholly owned and operated by the Tribe located on the Isabella reservation in Isabella County; MI. SCHD has been operating a low-income rental housing program for over 30 years, with funding from the Indian Housing Block Grant awarded through HUD. The SCHD is seeking to install 2 chain link fenceson the east and west sides along Ojibway Drive, Mt. Pleasant, MI.

Project Goals:

- Install a chain link fence along the east sideproperty line behind the row of houses on Ojibway Drive as shown in the attached map, (location 1)
- Location 1 is behind the seven houses beginning at 2398 Ojibway through to 2448 OjibwayRoad, coordinates are: 43°36'18N 84°42'12"W
- Install a chain link fence along the west side property line between the Broadway Park and the housing units on Ojibway Drive, and repair a 6 foot section of existing fence, (location 2)
- Location 2 is behind the row of houses beginning at 2385 Ojibway through 2445 Ojibway
- All work must be completed no later than three weeks after the start date
- Site clean up

Project Scope of Work:

- The fencing needed for location 1 is approximately 726 linear feet, five feet above ground.
- The fencing needed for location 2 is approximately 476 linear feet, five feet above ground
- The type of fence required is chain link

The project must be completed according to contract schedule.

- The work will commence within one (1) week upon execution of the service agreement
- Site prep, flagging utilities, and materials delivery 1 week

- Site clean-up and final Davis-Bacon wages report -1 week
