# Housing Winter Home Safety Tips

Please make sure your garden hose is unhooked and shut off from the house for the winter to prevent frozen pipes. Make sure temp inside house is at least 50 degrees to prevent frozen pipes. Make sure toys and yard decorations are put up for the winter and out of the way of sidewalks and drives. Make sure dryer vent are clear from lint and flowing normal if not clean out the lint in the dryer vent and dispose in trash. Housing



will plow your driveway if you are a elder or handicapped tenant. Housing will also remove snow in extreme conditions (snow over 6 inches high) for all tenants.
