Urging people who can't come early to stay and help to clean up and store everything away: e.g. sweep and clean Mide School ensure all food removed from Kitchen, disinfect, take out garbage, turn down heat and turn off lights, lock up... etc.

HUGS, TEARS PEACE

SPECIAL REMINDERS:

- Healing Bear Bundle: Those wishing to ready their healing bear bundle will need to have these items: burgundy cloth & thin black ribbon for women- black cloth & thin burgundy ribbon for men. 7 small black stones & a small piece of bear hide: toonie size for Canadians & silver dollar sized for Americans!
- Clans are reminded to wear your clan colours
- Asineeg for the Sweat Lodges have been asked for.
- (AGAIN) Come early or plan to stay later to help clean-up. There is much work to be done in preparation & all help is appreciated and especially so by the 'Spirit"
- Remember to bring your feast bundle: we are still working to eliminate the use of disposable dishes, etc.

IN ADDITION TO DOORWAY MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS FOR CEREMONIES:

- Clans are expected to contribute \$250.00 to the cost of the cook; & utilities @ the mide school and this is in addition to the Clan Feast food & items cost.
- DONATIONS ARE NEEDED & APPRECIATED: Anishinabe is always thinking 'What can/will I bring'
- Donations of Quality items for the Mide Mall: proceeds from the mall are applied to cover costs of ceremonies
- Medicines: CEDAR & BALSAM for SWEATS; cedar for our sacred fire and JD healing dance & healing ceremonies
- Sweetgrass; sage; natural tobacco; copal & charcoal burners; bear root & sweet flag etc. If you have bear hide or cloth to share then bring it along with you!
- Ceremony Feast food- wild meat; fish; traditional corn; wild rice; and tools for kitchen; i.e. coffee; herbal teas, maple sugar, maple syrup, general kitchen staples.
- Feast Cloths needed as fresh ones required for every feast. Also, need to remember Grandmother's instructions to cover food with cloth coverings (NOTE: not with torn pieces of fabric, but with prepared covers). So for all of our creative talented persons who can sew, this would be well appreciated.
