Primary Series:

The Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine is administered as a primary series of two doses, 1 month apart to individuals 18 years of age or older.

A third primary series dose of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine may be given at least 1 month following the second dose as authorized for administration to individuals at least 18 years of age who have undergone solid organ transplantation, or who are diagnosed with conditions that are considered to have an equivalent level of immunocompromise.

Booster Doses:

1. Patients may choose to receive a single Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine booster dose given at a minimum of 6 months after completing a primary series of Moderna OR Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to individuals:

- 65 years of age and older
- 18 through 64 years of age at high risk of severe COVID-19
- 18 through 64 years of age with frequent institutional or occupational exposure to SARS-CoV-2

2. Patients 18 and up, without restrictions, may choose to receive a single Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine booster dose after completing the one shot Johnson and Johnson (J & J) Vaccine given at a minimum of 2 months after primary injection.
