Eligibility for the Circle of Indigenous Arts Market:

1. Applicant must be an enrolled member of the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan, direct descendant of SCIT living within Isabella or Arenac County, enrolled member of a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe living within Isabella or Arenac County, or enrolled member of a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe living in Michigan who has previously attended COIA and has provided artistic services to the Ziibiwing Center.
2. All accepted artists must participate in the Best in Show competition AND have artwork available for sale.
3. Artwork must be handmade and/or created by the applicant, and not previously presented in other markets/shows.
4. Artist must provide at least 3 photos of your work.
5. Artist must provide proof of Tribal affiliation.
