- 2. All accepted artists must participate in the Best in Show competition AND have artwork available for sale.
- **3.** Artwork must be handmade and/or created by the applicant, and not previously presented in other markets/shows.
- **4.** Artist must provide at least 3 photos of your work.
- **5.** Artist must provide proof of Tribal affiliation.
