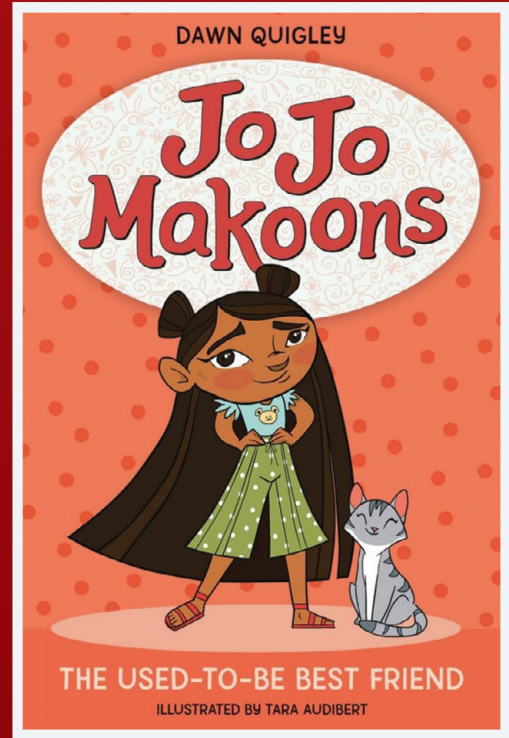


# Dawn Quigley
