ANISHINABE ANCESTRAL REPATRIATION OBSERVANCE

The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan and its Ziibiwing Center of Anishinabe Culture & Lifeways, in partnership with the Michigan Anishinaabek Cultural Preservation & Repatriation Alliance, will repatriate the ancestral human remains of (1) one Native American individual from Michigan State Police Lakeview Post #64 in Ionia County, Michigan. On October 14, 1971, human remains representing what was determined to be (1) one adult male individual were removed from a gravel pit in Bethany Township, Gratiot County, Michigan.

Women please wear skirts.

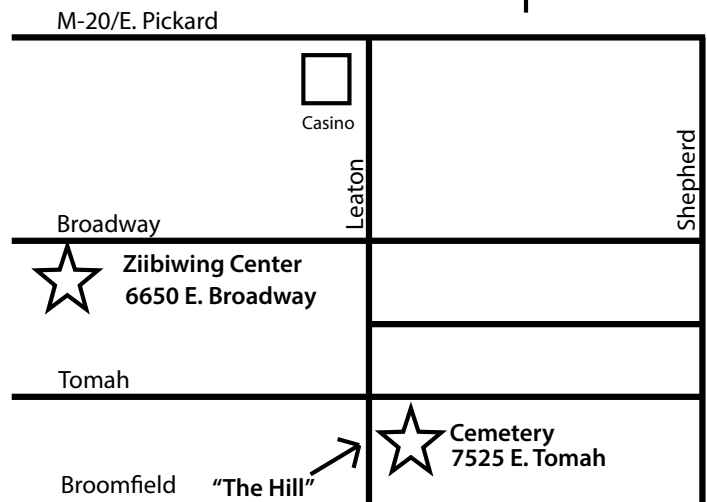
