## ANISHINABE ANCESTRAL REPATRIATION OBSERVANCE



The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan and its Ziibiwing Center of Anishinabe Culture & Lifeways, in partnership with the Michigan Anishinaabek Cultural Preservation & Repatriation Alliance (MACPRA), will repatriate the physical remains of 41 Native American individuals from the American Museum of Natural History, New York, New York, 1 Native American individual from the Toledo Zoological Society, Toledo, Ohio and 1 Native American individual from the Dearborn Historical Museum, Dearborn, Michigan. The planned repatriation and reburial will be executed in collaboration with the American Museum of Natural History, Toledo Zoological Society, Dearborn Historical Museum, 10 Federally-recognized tribes and 2 State historic tribes that comprise MACPRA and the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians.

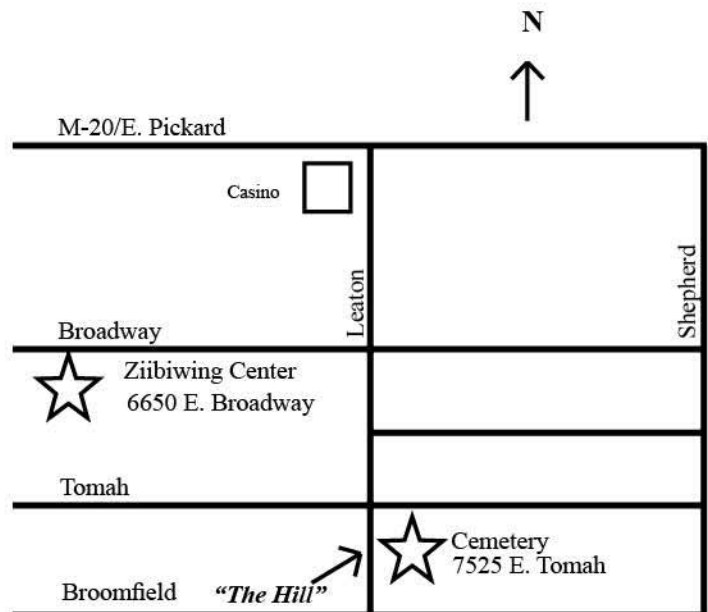
