Anishinabe Ancestral Remains Repatriation Observance

The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan and its Ziibiwing Center of Anishinabe Culture & Lifeways, in partnership with the Michigan Anishinaabek Cultural Preservation and Repatriation Alliance (MACPRA), will repatriate the ancestral human remains of (124) minimum number of individuals and 449 associated funerary objects from Michigan State University, (1) individual

from Michigan State Police, Lansing, Michigan, and (4+) individuals from a private land owner in Oscoda, Michigan.

The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe of Michigan invites the public to join with us at these important repatriation activities to create a collective public understanding and awareness of Native American ancestral issues and implications.
