UPDATED CDC GUIDELINES

Effective beginning Wednesday, January 5, 2022

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate) everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Isolate for 5 days
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are mostly resolved after 5 days, you may RTW with approval from Occupational Health all positive cases with symptoms past 5 days will isolate for the full 10 days.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days must wear a blue surgical mask, worn over the nose and mouth no cloth masks during this time
- If you have a fever, you may not RTW until your fever resolves

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine) and you...

- Have been boosted
- ► Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR
- Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months...
 - Wear a mask around others for 10 days
 - Test on day 5 all staff will be tested either at Nimkee or
 on their own—if testing on their own, results are required to
 be sent to the codnotify group within 5 days of the test and
 RTW slip is also required per current HR policy prior to
 returning to work
 - If you develop symptoms get a test and do not report to work — staff are required to notify management immediately and are not allowed to report to work with symptoms —management will send staff for testing
 - **Contact tracing remains at 72 hours from onset of symptoms or test date if no symptoms for positives
 - ** Proof of vaccine required at Nimkee or considered unvaccinated

- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over <u>6 months</u>
 <u>ago and are not boosted</u>
- Completed the primary series of J&J over <u>2 months ago and are not boosted</u>
- ▶ Are unvaccinated...
 - Stay home (Quarantine) for 5 days. After that, continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - All staff will be required to quarantine a minimum of 5 days
 - Test on day 5 all staff will be tested either at Nimkee or
 on their own if testing on their own, results are required
 to be sent to the cvdnotify group within 5 days of the test
 and RTW slip is also required per current HR policy prior
 to returning to work
 - If you develop symptoms get a test and do not report to work — staff are required to notify management immediately and are not allowed to report to work with symptoms — management will send staff for testing
