Weeeeeeee! Nbakinaage!!

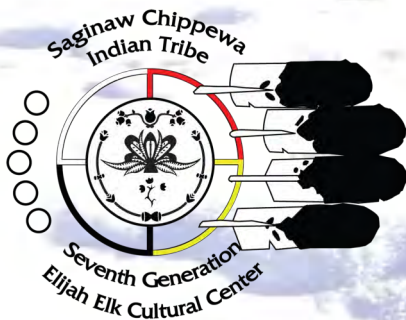


Snow Snake is a winter activity of the Anishinaabe. It can be played one on one or teams (4 person ideally).
