How to register as a Patient of Nimkee

Please contact the Business Office to request a registration packet. Once you have completed the packet, return it to the Business Office and they will enter your information into our system. You may then call the Medical Clinic at 989-775-4679 to arrange for a "New Patient Appointment."

Office visits

It is very important that you keep all of your appointments with your Primary Care Provider as recommended to ensure good quality of care. Please bring a list of your current medications, including over the counter medications, the dosages and how you are currently taking them to your appointment.

What does it mean to be accredited?

Patient Centered Medical Home

A Patient Centered Medical Home is a new concept of health care that is focused on the patient and family to provide comprehensive quality health care through a team approach.

A Medical Home is called a “home” because we want your clinic to be the first place you think of for your medical care. We have established health care teams to help improve coordination and continuity, to improve access to care, and to provide health care that is patient/family centered, compassionate and delivered in a culturally effective manner.

Nimkee Memorial Wellness is also participating in the Indian Health Services “Improving Patient Care Medical Home” (IPCMH), a National Initiative that is recognized as the I.H.S. model for a Patient Centered Medical Home.
