Volunteers are needed to help remove this invasive plant from the shoreline of the Saginaw Bay. Sea Grant Wisconsin states " European frog-bit mats can grow thick enough to affect boat traffic via tangling, as well as impairing the movement of big fish and diving ducks by not providing enough space between the plants for the fish and ducks to get through."

Volunteers will learn to identify and remove European frog-bit. Removal is done by hand pulling while wading or paddling. Limited kayaks and canoes will be available. Please feel free to bring your own boat.
