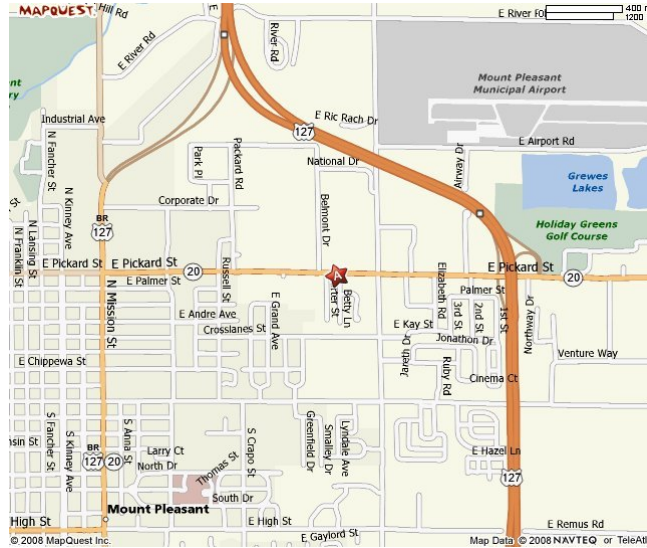

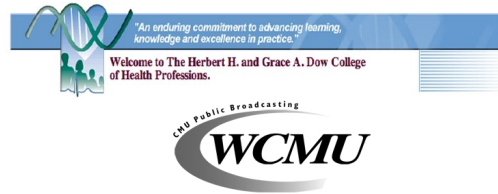

Course Objectives

Participants will:

1. discuss effective management, medically and behaviorally, of elders who resist care.
2. Identify warning signs and stages of Alzheimer's Disease, reversible dementias, medications used to treat AD, prevention guidelines, and startling dementia statistics.
3. Explain why early diagnosis of Alzheimer's Disease is so important.
4. Identify behavioral techniques to encourage better behavior in a challenging elder-helping way to reduce caregiver frustration and the occurrence of any level of elder abuse.
5. Describe creative methods to get obstinate elders to : accept a care giver, shower, take medication, attend adult day care, see a doctor, stop driving, move to a new residence, etc.
