In the matter of the missing four year old Tribal Member Carnel Chamberlain, as of today, June 25, 2012, search efforts continue in targeted areas by Tribal Police and Fire personnel. Volunteers will be requested as needed.

Carnel was reported missing on the Isabella Federal Reservation by his mother on June 21, 2012, at 10:12 p.m. and is registered with the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children. The case is still considered "suspicious" at this point.

The Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe would like to thank all of the hundreds of volunteers and agencies who assisted in efforts to find Carnel and continue to show support on behalf of the missing child and his family.
