



Andahwod Continuing Care Community & Elder Services Staff are committed to keeping the residents safe during the Covid-19 pandemic. Here are the safety measures we are taking to prevent an outbreak in the building. Please read these guidelines and call your elder resident and family members to remind them by following these precautions we can help keep the residents safe and healthy.

Andahwod Resident Prevention – Interim Guidelines

- Wash hands frequently and use hand sanitizer.
- Practice social distancing – no physical contact and try to remain 6 feet apart.
- **No visitors, guests, and/or family members are allowed in apartments.**
- No outside housekeeping. Please make arrangements with Andahwod Housekeeping.
- Residents should limit their physical contact with other residents and staff.
- Andahwod Administrative, Kitchen, Maintenance and Housekeeping Staff will only have minimal necessary contact with residents.
- Only one resident per table.
- Only necessary medical transports provided by Andahwod staff. Shopping will be limited and requires a notice. Andahwod staff can assist with store delivery ordering.
- Andahwod residents are encouraged to only leave the building if necessary. If you leave the building please use your private apartment door. Please refrain from roaming around the building if you leave.
- Residents who require assistance have their temp checked by the Nursing staff.
- Independent residents must notify Nursing staff immediately if they have fever (100 degrees +), loss of taste and/or smell, shortness of breath, sore throat, and/or coughing (increased or unusual).

Andahwod Employee Prevention

- All employees need to have temperature checked and recorded at the beginning of their shift. Complete a self-screening for Covid-19 symptoms. Report exposure or potential exposure by protocol to supervisor.
- All employees must wash hands and use hand sanitizer frequently.
- Employees must wear gloves when entering a resident's apartment when having direct contact.
- All employees must properly clean and disinfect own work spaces and other areas frequently.
- Please be mindful when you are not at work, be safe and remember you care for the most at-risk age group.
