The ancestral remains and funerary objects to be reburied were repatriated in cooperation with the Peabody Museum of Archaeology and Ethnology at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts and the Bureau of Indian Affairs. The ceremony will be officiated by Curtis Hopkins at the Nibokaan Cemetery (the place for sleeping until the great day we will meet again) located behind the Pow Wow grounds. A feast will follow at the Ziibiwing Center's Gchi Giigidiwigamig (Big Discussion) Meeting Rooms. We invite all community members to attend.
