Operated from June 30, 1893 to June 6, 1934

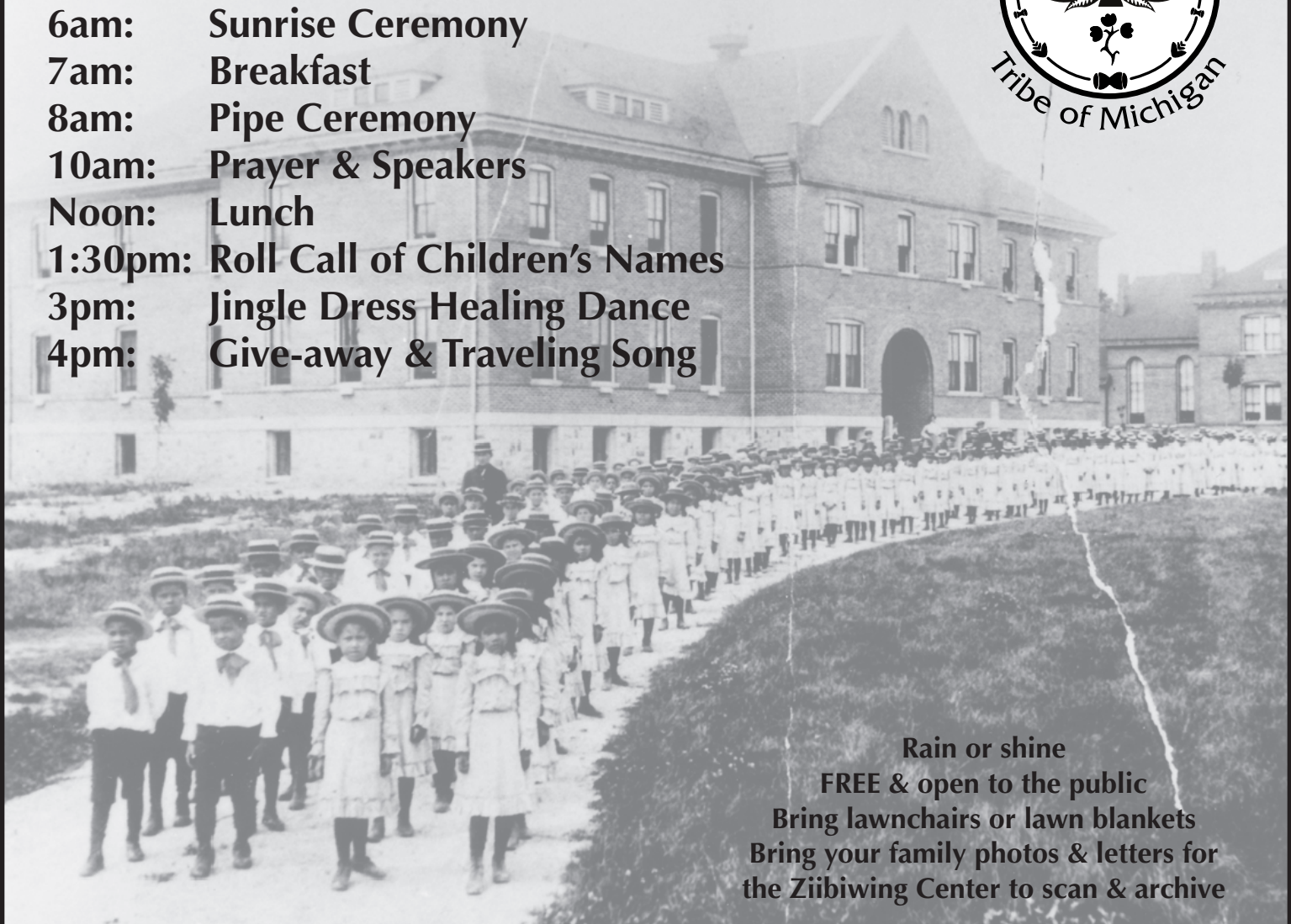
