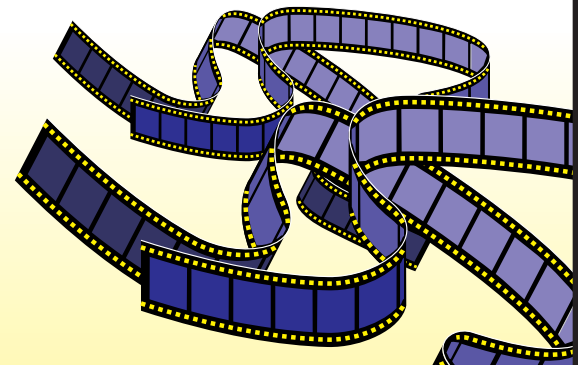
Gchi Giigidiwigamig (Big Discussion Rooms) • Zibiwing Center
