## **Project Description**

In partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) through a Rural Business Development grant, the Ziibiwing Center of Anishinabe Culture & Lifeways (Ziibiwing) is offering an opportunity to participate in Business Incubator Project. At least seven Tribal Members will be selected by an external Selection Committee through an application process. The project will provide artists and emerging entrepreneurs with small business training to expand and/or start their business. Community-based training will be provided for the selected Tribal entrepreneurs to develop their business intelligence so they are better equipped to create their brand, manage tax laws, and launch e-commerce platforms.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Applicants must be an enrolled member of the Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe.
