The day started with a Water Ceremony with Judy Pamp, Ziibiwing's Assistant Director. She shared the Water Prayer in Ojibwemowin and English. The prayer gives thanks for the gift of water and acknowledges its importance to all life on earth. The day proceeded with lessons about wild ricing, including a simulation of rice harvesting, winnowing and cooking wild rice. This was later followed by a presentation on the history of ricing with a sample of cooked wild rice. It was a beautiful day to enjoy the sun on the Ziibiwing patio and view live water bugs while learning all about them with the help of the SCIT Environmental Team. The group also enjoyed making butterflies from repurposed paper! It was a beautiful day to learn about and enjoy the gifts of Mother Earth. We have Mother Earth Week events every spring. 
