EVENT RULES: Basketball Shots

- **Event Rules:** You will have 8 basketballs to make as many shots as you can. You may shoot from wherever you would like within the court.
 - Free throws/layups are worth 1 point.
 - Anything else inside the three-point line/arch is worth 2 points.
 - Shots made outside the three-point line are worth 3 points.
- **Shooting Lines:** The distance of the three-point shot is 19' 9" (line to backboard), and distance of the free throw shot is 15' (line to backboard).
- **Crossing Line:** Participants must stay behind the line that they are attempting, or the shot will not count.
- **Final Score:** Will be determined by total shots made.
- **Ages:** Open to ages 10 and up.
