



VICTIM IMPACT STATEMENT

As a victim of a crime you have the right to attend the offender's sentencing hearing that is scheduled on _____. You also have the right to present your victim impact statement to the Tribal Court and the offender to allow you to share your experience and how this crime has affected your life.

Your statement should be honest and specific. If you would like your statement to be used to assist the probation department with their sentencing recommendation, please submit this form to the Victim Advocate's Office three to five days before the sentencing hearing. Additional pages can be added to this document if necessary.

Possible information that you may wish to include in this statement:

- A written account of the personal harm that you have suffered.
- A description of how members of your family been affected by this crime.
- Traumatic reactions that you are experiencing such as feelings of anxiety, fatigue, grief, fear, and diminished sense of safety and trust.
- Details of financial losses that you have suffered due to this crime.
