

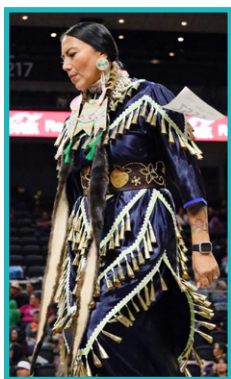
# OUT OF THE DARK

Heather Syrette is Oneida First Nation of Ontario, Canada, and Little Traverse Bay Band Odawa. She has been dancing at powwows since she could walk, and has been attending ceremonies in both her Haudenosaunee and Midewin community.

Along with learning her culture and language Heather received her Master's in Social Work from University of Michigan, as well as a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work from Central Michigan University. Heather has extensive knowledge in Indian Child Welfare, domestic violence advocacy, and therapy with individuals across a lifespan.

Heather has spent many years working in tribal communities both urban and reservation settings. Heather is currently a therapist at Saginaw Chippewa Indian Tribe's Behavioral Health.
