Showcasing nearly 100 examples of contemporary Anishinabe porcupine quill art, the fully bilingual (English and Anishinabemowin) exhibition celebrates the vitality and importance of this art form in Anishinabe culture. The exhibition includes featured documentary photographs by Minnie Wabanimkee, media presentations, and hands-on activities.

The exhibition is a collaboration of Ziibiwing, Michigan State University Museum, Michigan Traditional Arts Program, Grand Traverse Tribe of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians, Ojibwe Cultural Foundation, Michigan State University Outreach and Engagement, and MSU Native American Institute with the assistance of many other individuals and organizations.
