



- 1. Visitors are not allowed to touch any of the artworks within the Ziibiwing Center, unless designated interactive or hands-on area. All of the objects within the Ziibiwing Center are fragile and may be damaged by the oils in human skin.
- 2. Food, drink, or gum is not allowed within the exhibit areas.
- 3. Walk carefully throughout the Ziibiwing Center. If part of a group, always remain with the other members of your group. Make sure that you do not bump into cases, walls, or works of art. Running and horseplay are not allowed within the Ziibiwing Center.
- 4. Keep voices at a minimal level within the exhibit areas. Be respectful of others who may be enjoying a tour/visit.
- 5. Turn off all cells and pagers within the exhibit areas.
- 6. Docent-guided tours have priority. Therefore, if a docent is with a group in an exhibit area that you wish to see, we ask that you wait until they have finished before you enter the area with your group.
- 7. Taking photos is allowed, as long as they are taken with a *non-flash camera*.
- 8. Following these simple rules will ensure a fun, safe, informative visit for you and your group, and will help protect the works of art within the Ziibiwing Center from harm.
